Without academic consideration, late penalties of 2% per day will apply. Note that the course instructor will assign a second, independent marker for the final essay. Each supervisor will be expected to serve as a second marker for the same number of essays as the number of I.S. students they supervise each term. The independent marker will receive a copy of Page 2 of this form.

Written products MUST be submitted to TurnItIn on the course website before a grade is submitted. A mark must be submitted for each Independent Study course, even though the student may be continuing the project throughout the entire year with two consecutive Independent Study courses. NOTE: GRADES ARE DUE NO LATER THAN ONE WEEK AFTER THE END OF CLASSES.
