General Information about the Conference

This year's Undergraduate Thesis Conference will be held at the University of Windsor, based in the Odette School of Business, which is at the corner of Wyandotte St. W., and Sunset Ave., in the northwest area of Windsor, Ontario, on the Detroit river. (Note that the city of Detroit is actually north of Windsor, and going toward the river means you are going north).

The Thesis Conference has a long history within the Ontario university system. It has always served as a great opportunity for thesis students to:

1. Present their thesis research to colleagues in a supportive environment.
2. Learn about research being carried out at other universities in Ontario.
3. Meet students and faculty members from other universities in Ontario.
4. Relax and celebrate the end of the year (and the thesis).

Call for Submissions

Participants in this year's Conference, April 30, University of Windsor, will be required to submit an Abstract summarizing their presentation, using the link below, containing the title and description of their study, and containing as many results as are known at the time of submission. This year's Conference likely will be based entirely on oral presentations, and this is the presentation method that should be planned for. Any participation via posters will depend on the total volume of submissions. For any presentations accepted as posters, presenters will be notified of such as promptly as possible.

PLEASE NOTE: To ensure participation, the abstract must not exceed 150 words, and must be received, using the online web submission procedure, no later than **midnight, Wednesday, March 24.**

In due course, participants will receive notification of their presentation times, plus building and room locations. Please note: Abstracts may be submitted, giving as many details and information as possible, even if statistical analyses are not totally completed at the time of submission. *Abstracts are not to be co-authored.*

*** **Note carefully**: **IMPORTANT: All participants must bring in any power point material with them, on a memory (USB) key.**

- ❖ Registration will be held in the Odette Building, Wyandotte St. at Sunset Ave., beginning at 8 AM. There is no registration fee or lunch cost for presenters or faculty representatives.
- ❖ Presentations will be held in the Odette Building, and may also extend to the Toldo Health Education & Learning Centre, and Erie Hall, depending on the volume of submissions.
- ❖ Lunch will be held, 12-2 pm., in Vanier Hall. There will be a \$5 lunch charge for non-participants.
- ❖ Parking is available in Parking Lot V (see directions below).
- ❖ Please note carefully the hotel information below. *Please note the dates by which reservations must be made*, to secure the special Conference rates (Hilton and Radisson = March 30. Holiday Inn = April 15). The Hilton and Radisson are on Riverside Drive, right on the Detroit river, directly across from the city of Detroit. The Holiday Inn is on Huron Church Rd., just south of the river. Each hotel is about 2 km. from the University of Windsor.

Driving directions, from highway 401 to hotels:

For the Hilton and Radisson hotels, take 401 West to the Windsor area, then exit onto Walker Rd. north toward the Detroit river (watch carefully for Walker Rd. on the exit sign), go about 10 km. north to Riverside Dr., then turn left (westward) to the Hilton and Radisson hotels, about 1 min. west from Walker Rd.

Alternatively, follow the "Bridge to USA" exit to Dougall north, which becomes Ouellette Ave., which runs north directly toward the river to Riverside Dr., then turn left onto Riverside, and the Hilton and Radisson hotels are immediately on your left.

For the Holiday Inn, follow the Bridge to USA exit to Huron Church Rd. Follow Huron Church Rd. north toward the river (and the University), and the hotel will be on the left hand side.

Driving directions to main campus

From Hwy. 401: Follow directions for "Bridge to U.S.A." to Huron Church Road. Proceed north on Huron Church Road, approximately 10 kilometres. Stay to right and proceed past bridge entrance along Patricia Rd. Turn right (east) onto Wyandotte Street to the University, at Wyandotte and Sunset.

From Windsor Airport: From the main airport parking lot, turn right (west) onto County Road 42, and turn right at Walker Road. Continue along Walker to Riverside (10 km.), turn left at Riverside, and continue west to Sunset Ave. (5 min.), then left to the University.

From VIA Rail station: Proceed west along Riverside Drive approximately 5 kilometres to Sunset Ave. Left (south) onto Sunset Ave., to the University.

From Ambassador Bridge: Once you have cleared Canada Customs, take the bridge exit on the extreme right that indicates downtown Windsor. This will bring you to Huron Church Road, travelling north. Turn right (east) onto Wyandotte Street, right (south) onto Sunset Ave, to visitor parking lot V.

From Windsor-Detroit Tunnel: Once you have cleared Canada Customs, turn left (west) onto Park Street. Immediately turn right (north) onto Ouellette Avenue. Proceed to University Avenue, the next traffic light. Turn left (west) onto University Ave, approximately 2 kilometres to Sunset Ave. Left (south) onto Sunset Ave, to the University.

PARKING INFORMATION:

Parking for participants is in lot V, on Sunset Ave., just south of Wyandotte St. W. The location is opposite and just south of Harvey's restaurant on Wyandotte St. There is no charge for parking in this lot, which has a coin operated machine at the entrance, but no payment is required for Conference participants.

Directions to Conference Parking from Hotels:

From the Hilton or Radisson hotels (they are next door to each other), proceed west along Riverside Dr., (along the river), to Sunset (2 km.), turn left onto Sunset, and continue south to just past Wyandotte St., (2 blocks), and parking lot V will be on your left.

From the Holiday Inn Select hotel, proceed north (toward river) on Huron Church Rd., be sure to stay to the right past the Ambassador Bridge complex, then turn right onto Wyandotte, then immediately right again onto Sunset, then south to parking lot V on the left side.
